	assistants specialized in the food sector.				
	They will be in the beginning of their third year and thus will have worked for 15 weeks in French shops.

	3 weeks in October 2013 (this is a proposal)
	Conditions of work placement
	• Our school will ask for a "Leonardo" grant which will co finance the cost of the trip and accommodation of the pupils.
	<ul> <li>This placement consists in a training period in a professional environment and enables the trainees to acquire skills and finally get their diploma.</li> </ul>
	• Each trainee will get cultural and foreign language training enabling him or her to carry out the work placement in a company under the best possible conditions.
	• One or two teachers will come with the trainees during the work placement, to guide them and evaluate their skills.
	Skills to be developed by the pupils during their work placement
	Discover new ways of trade and sale, like local products, direct sale for example
	Develop new skills for relationships, advising customers, communication in a multicultural context
	Communicate in a foreign language in professional and social situations (in English and other European language)
	Strengthen their ability to adapt to new situations, to be mobile, autonomous and responsible
	• Deepen their knowledge of quality procedures in Europe, control and security standards in food production and sale
